- A.** Tim Finley of SageGlass presented us with an overview of their products and how they work within buildings. Tim explained that the glass they are working with tints on demand, which changes the way people experience the buildings they are in. The on demand glass improves occupant comfort by reducing heat and glare, creates greater connection to the outdoors, which eliminates the need for solar control solutions. This glass increases usable space with real-time sun control. It allows for more design options. This glass tints intelligently in response to the sun. An intelligent algorithm selects the right tint level for occupant comfort and well-being. Tim states that even though the price is a little higher than normal, he also indicates the amount of money saved over time. Steve Underdahl felt this was great and hopes that down the road we can utilize the company in future plans.
